



- 1. The author has permission to view the organization template group.
- 2. The author has permission to view the survey form item.
- 3. The survey form item is added to the organization template group.

Share selected templates with entire organization and others with a specific group.

Best practices and important considerations

- Keep a good handle on who can share templates within your organization
 - Configure your Survey123 design templates group so only trusted users can share new designs with it
- Different people need different templates
 - Some templates you will want to share with ALL survey authors in your org
 - Many others will be only available to certain groups
 - Leverage the ArcGIS sharing model to control who can see what templates
- Take pride of your design templates
 - Make them look nice (thumbnails, theme)
 - Add a description to the template
 - Share templates that inspire people
- Survey123 designer and Connect
 - If your survey design was authored in Connect, it will appear only to Connect authors
 - Survey123 web designer forms will appear in both Connect and the Designer template gallery



One of the new features included in the ArcGIS Survey123 October 2022 release (3.16) is the *Organization templates* setting. This option allows an organization administrator to share template surveys with other form authors in the organization. These templates appear in the *New Survey* dialog in Survey123 Connect or the Survey123 web designer.






Many organizations create the same kind of survey repeatedly, so using an organization template allows the survey author to quickly find and create the new survey and then make any further customizations that are needed.

Templates can also be used to model best practices in survey creation. Just as the *Esri samples* section demonstrate the capabilities and best practices for using various Survey 123 features like appearances and


