Fauna sightings/evidence

Further comments

30 degree upward slope 1.5m deep with D bramb and F young to sm ash 10m tall. Ivy and red fescue ground flora. Timber post and rail fence at top of bank. Bank plateaus after dead end access point at TN with no bramb but privet, nettle, ivy, eld and elm also present. Then ledlandii 12 m tall along garden boundary fence with ivy and nettle ground flora. Verge narrows to 1m adj to leyland with footpath starting. VLF grt plantain and knot grass along footpath
