Capabilities currently under development

- Stationing event type support
 - REST operations for Geometry to Station and Station to Geometry
- Event editing in Pro
 - Adding and editing events using core tools and attribute table
 - Attribute sets
- Generate Calibration Points
 - M on Route and Attribute Field calibration method
- Display measures as a cursor moves along a route in the map

Support Incidents/Defects

- BUG-000143396 Deleting a version in Roads & Highways 10.8.1 does not release route locks (developer fixing)
- BUG-000144531 Running Export Network returns different results if input layer is stored in file gdb or enterprise gdb (developer fixing)
