- Event editing in Pro
 - Add Single Point, Single Line, Multiple Point, and Multiple Line event tools
 - Split Events
 - Create/Modify Attribute Sets
 - Conflict Prevention in event editing tools in Pro
- Release stabilization

Support Incidents/Defects

- BUG-000146863 Some unique value symbologies do not appear in ArcGIS Event Editor's Layers pane when using some styles (Fixed in 10.9)
- BUG-000147512 ArcGIS Event Editor displays an unexpected behavior when using the Linear Event widget with a traditional versioning enabled linear referencing system (LRS) dataset. The highlight cannot be cleared while the widget is opened. (Currently being investigated)














DATA VALIDATIONS HISTORY

- Pre-ESRI Database: Nightly validations were run to cross check data stored in the LRS versus the event data tables
- 2014 : Switch to Road and Highways, vendor creates data validations custom web application
- 2019: ArcGIS Data Reviewer
- 2020: Safe Software's data integration platform FME



Data integration software

- Transform data
- Integrate spatial data
- Data conversion
- Data validation







Greater processing speed when compared to ArcGIS Data Reviewer





Replaced and consolidated outdated validations

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No specialized coding knowledge required

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Cleaner Data, easier HPMS submission

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


More frequent publishing in the future

Event Layer Validations by User

Description

This runs most of validations against a user version to check current errors. While this can't run every validation that are performed nightly, it can check the majority of them.

Parameters

Version - Select the your ESRI version from the drop down list.

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Route - Enter the NLF_ID of the route to run the query on. Multiple routes can be run at once, insert a space after each NLF_ID, (i.e. SFRAIR00270++C SFRAIR00070++C). <- Note: You also must enter the county code in the other parameter.

File

The output file will be saved here: K:\RoadwayInformation\04 Validations\05 FME Validation Output\User Run Validations\Event Layers Note: if there are no errors no file will be created.














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
